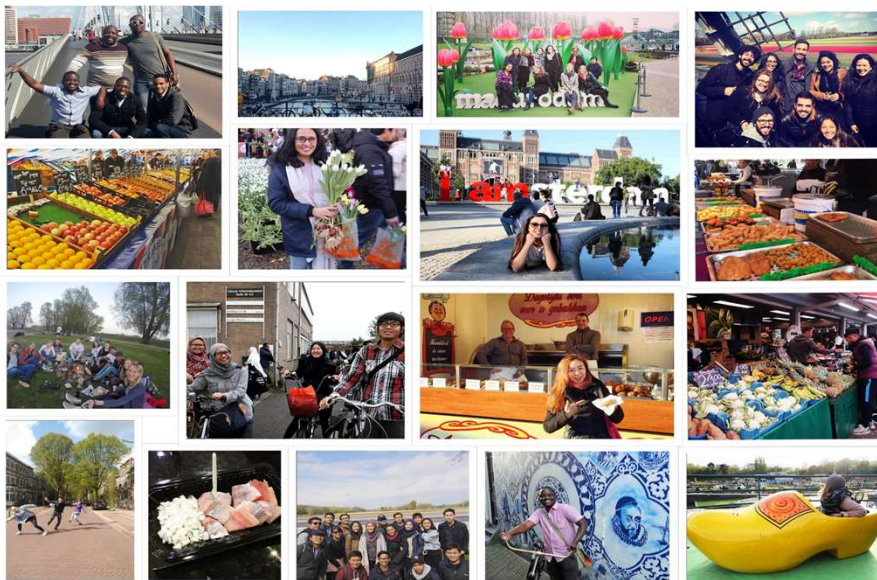

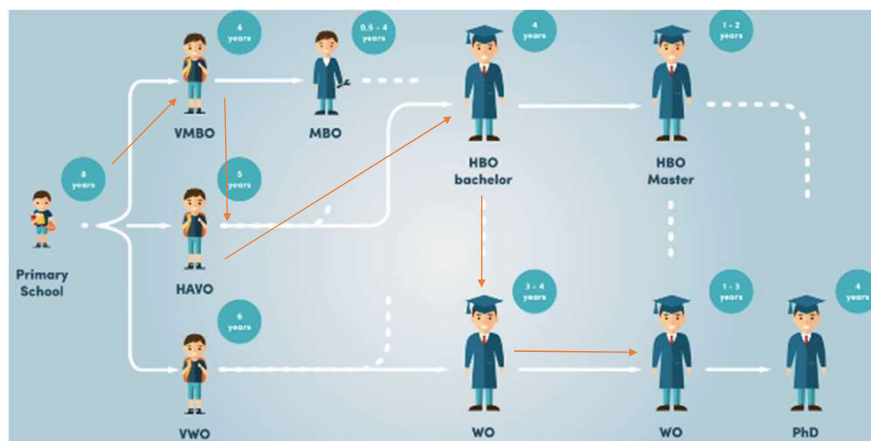

- Remedial measures are being considered, including:
 - Subsidies for unforeseen expenses.
 - Use of study grants for non-refundable expenses.
 - Flexible changes in course dates.
